To Somerset Lake Pool and Clubhouse

Our goal is to be a resident-focused and family-friendly facility. We encourage appropriate behavior and provide guidelines so residents of all ages can have a good experience.

SIGN-IN: At the front gate, all residents must sign-in daily when entering the pool grounds. No entry at the back gate.

GUEST POLICY: A maximum of 6 guests per family/residence per day is allowed. Guest wristbands may be purchased at the sign-in table at a cost of \$5 per guest per day. Children under the age of 2 are free. Grandchildren of Somerset resident grandparents are not considered guests. Nanny or caregiver accompanying a Somerset resident family member is not considered a guest.

POOL PARTIES: Personal pool parties are prohibited. It is not fair for the other residents trying to enjoy the facilities when a family brings more than 6 guests in for a party.

BABY POOL: The “baby pool” is Not Guarded and is reserved exclusively for the use of children under the age of five (5). Adult supervision is required at all times. Children cannot be left unattended in the baby pool area – they are the sole responsibility of an accompanying adult/guardian. The gate to the baby pool area must be kept closed at all times.

DIAPER POLICY: In compliance with directives from the Health Department, all non-toilet trained children must wear swim diapers and protective plastic swim diapers while in either pool. Children who are not properly attired will not be allowed in the water for health reasons.

CHILDREN AGED 0-7: Must be accompanied by a parent/guardian over the age of 18. If your child cannot swim unattended, please remain within arm's reach at all times. Please note that floaties are not a substitute for parental supervision.

CHILDREN AGED 8-12: Must be accompanied by a parent/guardian (over the age of 18) Children ages 8-12 may use the clubhouse game room unchaperoned IF their parent/guardian is on site AND a permission form has been submitted to the Clubhouse Office. The rules of the clubhouse must be reviewed by the parent/guardian AND child in order to sign the permission form. If the rules are not followed, a verbal warning will be given. If behavior is not corrected, child will be sent back outside to their parent/guardian and lose their privileges inside the Clubhouse for the day. A 2nd offense will result in loss of privileges. No child aged 12 or under can be left completely unattended in the clubhouse or pool area.

TEENS AGED 13 to 15: May use the clubhouse and pool area on their own with a signed permission form. The rules of the clubhouse must be reviewed by the parent/guardian AND teen in order to sign the permission form. If the rules are not followed, a verbal warning will be given. If behavior is not corrected, teen will be asked to leave the clubhouse and pool area and lose their privileges for the day. A 2nd offense will result in loss of privileges.

RESTROOMS: Restrooms are located on the fitness level of the clubhouse. The door will be open during pool season. Please dry off before entering the clubhouse. Restrooms on the main club level should not be used by residents at the pool. Shirts/coverups and shoes required in the clubhouse, including restrooms. If you have wet clothes on, please do not use the restroom on the club level. If restrooms need attention, please office staff member.

SAFETY RULES

1. Swim at your own risk when a lifeguard is not on duty.
- 2.Children under 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian when a lifeguard is not on duty.
- 3.No diving, running, dunking or rough horseplay.
- 4.No glass or other breakable containers of any kind.
- 5.Water accessories and games may be allowed in the pool at times when it is not crowded, at the discretion of the Lifeguards on duty. Visibility is necessary for safety.
- 6.All personal injuries, regardless of how slight, must be reported immediately to the lifeguard on duty. Any person with an obvious communicable disease, skin eruption, fungus infections, ear, eye, nose, or throat infection, or wearing bandages may not use the pool.
- 7.The pool staff will always be in charge and will have complete authority to enforce all rules including limiting the activity of anyone risking his or her own safety and/or the safety and enjoyment of others.
- 8.The lifeguards are required to clear the pool when signs of either thunder or lightning are present. Please cooperate and exit the pool area quickly. There will be a 30-minute delay before members are allowed to re-enter the pool.

BEHAVIOR

1. Please request a member of the pool staff or lifeguards to open or close umbrellas.
2. No running, pushing, horseplay, or other disruptive or unruly behavior.
3. No vulgar or inappropriate language and/or gestures.
4. No smoking. This includes cigarettes, cigars, vaping, etc.
5. No wet clothes in the clubhouse. Shirts/coverups and shoes must be worn inside.
6. All sand must be rinsed off with hose provided before entering the pool area or pool.
7. Trash must be deposited in the receptacles provided.
8. Conduct affecting the safety or comfort of others is not permitted (i.e., Loud music, water guns, large flotation devices up to the discretion of the Lifeguard, etc.)
9. The pool staff reserves the right to suspend the privileges of any resident or guest who violates established rules for a period not to exceed 24 hours.
10. The Board of Directors will determine when longer suspensions or expulsions are required.
11. Parents are responsible for their children's conduct, not lifeguards or clubhouse staff.
12. Lifeguards have complete authority during pool hours and disregarding their instructions may jeopardize your ability to enjoy the pool facilities.
13. No skateboarding, rollerblading or bikes on the pool deck or wooden decking around the clubhouse, lake, basketball, and tennis courts.
14. No pets allowed.
15. Only soft or foam balls are permitted. (No hard balls such as basketballs, footballs, volleyballs, baseballs, etc.)

QUIET HOURS: We haven't set up quiet hours this year, but if you need them, please reach out the clubhouse manager and accommodations will be made.

Although provisions for the safety of all residents and guests have been made, Somerset Lake Service Corporation assumes no responsibility for anyone using the pool, clubhouse, playground, basketball/tennis courts, and/or volleyball area.
